- Food and Fun – Reviewed the suggestions from the post Food and Fun meeting last year and will implement some of the ideas. We have about 10 raffle board items but still need more.
- Donations are welcome and encouraged to help keep our costs down. Members are also asked to help collect door prizes. Raffle tickets are available for sale. Contact Doris if you need some to sell. They are also available for purchase at local businesses.

### **New Business**

- Meat Raffle – Gary and Rhonda volunteered for 7/1. Need a volunteer to sell tickets on 7/15.
  - The town is getting bids to put metal roofs on the buildings and replace the bathroom doors. The club will be asked to participate in the cost of repairs.
  - The club is responsible for bathroom maintenance and cleaning. It was agreed that the club should purchase a power washer.
  - The ball park field needs maintenance. Chuck will get an estimate to fertilize from the mowing company. In the meantime, we will spray for weeds and drag the field.
  - We need a trail maintenance work day to trim branches. Bill feels it should be OK until our regular work day in the fall when there is less ATV traffic.
  - The new rack for the tractor is ready to be picked up at Lulich.
  - Bill dropped a bucket of gravel near the Chipmunk and will drop another next week.
  - We will only be able to process memberships with the AWSC one time per month due to increased processing fees. Members are asked to pay their dues timely. We will look into payment options through Pay Pal and/or Venmo.
  - Bill attended the training class for the new SNARES system that the DNR implemented for submitting trail maintenance reports. This system will be mandatory by June 2018.
