Old Business

Jean has ordered biffies. Mike will donate the use of his trailer to eliminate the need for a dumpster which should save about \$500.

- Jean reported that the Minong student painted some the equipment and did maintenance to the ball field. The metal swing set is still in need of paint, so Jean volunteered to handle.
