Bills – Dennis submitted receipts for paddle wheel prizes for Food and Fun. Doris submitted receipts for Food and Fun prizes and supplies. Loren submitted a bill from Guitar Center for the sound system and a bill for a raffle prize. The sound system was slightly more than the \$1000 budgeted, so Loren and Leah will donate the balance. Marlene requested a check to pay for the corn for Food and Fun. A Dave/Loren motion passed to pay bills.

- Trail Report - Trails are in great shape and are being groomed twice a week.

- Fall ride is scheduled for October 13. Meet at 10 a.m. at the Stop A Sec. Details to follow.
- Chuck, Dave, Bill Warn and Doris repaired and painted the pavilion and swing set.
- Food and Fun – Thank you to Birch Trail Campground for donating ice cream. Raffle tickets are selling fast and several businesses have already sold out. We have over 25 raffle boards and a couple of bucket raffles. A Mike/Dave motion passed to donate the sweatshirts that we have in stock to use as door prizes. Volunteers are needed on Friday to help clean the park, shuck corn and organize supplies. Set up will be at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and gates open at noon. Anyone interested in helping prep, set up or during the event can meet at the park.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Northwest Trails – Chuck attended the August meeting and learned that Douglas County is responsible for grooming the ATV Road 41 to Buckley Island Road. They haven't groomed this summer since their resources have been focused on repairing trails damaged by the June storms. Chuck received permission from Mark Schroeder to groom this section of trail for the remainder on the season.
- Chuck proposed researching opening a road route from where Road 41 dead ends on White Fish Lake Road north to County Road Y to Gordon. This would give ATVs a more direct route

between Wascott and Gordon. There was also discussion about running a trail along the power line on County Road T to Highway 53. This was tabled for further discussion at future meetings.

- Nomination of Officers - Dave nominated Mike Pederson as Vice President. Loren nominated Doris as Secretary.
- There will be a large ad for Food and Fun in the Sunday Duluth News Tribune donated by Rockney Johnson.
- Jean noticed that the basketball court and parking area were developing several cracks. Jon suggested we notify the town and they can fill in the spring when they do other town roads.
