### 1. Call to Order

- Capital budget discussion ongoing including future building expansion vs relocation.
- Future planning includes evaluating long-term facility options and lease opportunities.

- 4 birds harvested, 10 missed.
- Club expressed appreciation for volunteers and participants.

## 5. Equipment Manager Report

- Summer grader drag weld repairs completed including reinforced plate and mount repair.
- Tucker is at Track Inc for rear differential repairs. Other repairs done with annual inspection may cover transportation at no cost. Track adjuster scheduled for replacement.
- Ranger transmission replaced under warranty.
- Diamond brusher hose replaced and repositioned to prevent future damage.
- Continued discussion regarding indoor fuel tank compliance. Plan to meet with Fire Inspector Dave King for further review.

## 6. Trail Boss Report

- All trails mowed and brushed; ready for summer use.
- Trail cleanup scheduled for May 9 at 9:00am.
- Grading to begin following cleanup.
- Signage updates targeted for completion by June 1.
- Removal of outdated ATV road signs in Wascott underway.
- Additional signage improvements needed in select areas.
- Potential grading needed at County Rd Y on new trail sections.
- Timber sale activity east of 3 Mile Road being monitored.
- Madison Road lots purchased by a member; trail 3 impact possible.

## 7. Northwest Trails Updates

- AWSC scholarship program remains underutilized; safety class instructors encouraged to promote.
- Gordon Dam repair scheduled next year; no winter trail impact expected.
- Grant request for trail improvements not approved.
- ATV trail bridge funding needs identified statewide (126 bridges across 3,100 miles).
- Next club payment expected in August.

- Continued focus on growing membership base.
